## The new member application process

- The potential member must be proposed and seconded by a Rand Club member of good standing.
- The application form must be signed by the proposer and seconder, and submitted together with a brief Curriculum Vitae by email to [roanne@randclub.co.za](mailto:roanne@randclub.co.za)
- For those who are interested in becoming Members but who do not know any Members personally, applications can be made directly to the Membership Secretary
- As per the club's tradition, the names of the candidates will be posted on the Club notice board for 30 days to record any objections to the applicant becoming a Rand Club Member, after which the applications are submitted to the General Committee for final approval.
- An administration fee of R500 is payable to the club.
- Upon approval of the application, the candidate will be requested to submit a specimen signature to Ms Roanne Lloyd.
- The new Member will be issued with a parking decal a Rand Club access card (once stock is available)
- It is a long-standing tradition for the newly elected candidate to invite his/her proposer to lunch at the Club to celebrate the new Member's initiation into Rand Club.
